

## Margaret Kuzyk Awarded the 2019 SES Engineer of the Year

On Thursday Sep 26<sup>th</sup> at the Saskatoon Engineering Society AGM and Banquet, Margaret Kuzyk P.Eng, FEC, FGC(Hon.), FCSSE was awarded the honour of Engineer of the Year. A civil engineer by training, Margaret is a leading expert in building codes. Her career included working on projects for the cities of Estevan and Saskatoon as well as being the Government of Saskatchewan Chief Building Official for 15 years. She also held several professional roles within the Federal Government and in industry with AMEC. She was also a private consultant for several years.

In addition to Margaret's varied work history, her nominator listed some of her many volunteer activities advancing the engineering profession. Notably, she was the first female President of APEGS in 1997-98. Her volunteer efforts in supporting the College of Engineering and the University of Saskatchewan have been numerous. Nationally, she is an Alternate Warden of the Corporation of the Seven Wardens and locally, she is an Honorary Warden of Kipling Camp #4 administering the Iron Rings. Her leadership and organizational skills have made notable contributions to the City of Saskatoon, the Province of Saskatchewan, and beyond.
